

## TIMELINE FOR PROPOSAL SUBMISSIONS

When preparing a proposal for submission the earlier you can notify the department and college the better. The following timeline is based on the minimum amount of time needed to get a proposal through the system for the best review. Anything less and you take the risk of errors not being caught due to a minimal review.

### 15 days before due date –

- Submit a [Platinum Sheet](#) to the College of Engineering

### 10 business days before due date –

- Send documents to the Grant Coordinator for review:
  - Program Guidelines
  - Budget
  - Budget justification

### 7 business days before due date –

- Submit the [GoldSheet](#) for routing
- or For help with the GoldSheet complete a [GoldSheet Initiation Request form](#) and send it the Grant Coordinator along with the following required attachments:
  - Final Budget
  - Final Budget Justification
  - Narrative (draft)
  - Program Guidelines (solicitation)
  - Transmittal Letter (if ISU is a subaward on the proposal)

### 5 business days before due date –

- GoldSheet needs to arrive in OSPA's queue for review
- [FastLane](#) or [Cayuse](#)
  - Download Opportunity in sponsor's submission system
  - Enter Budget and Budget Justification in the sponsor's submission system
  - Allow OSPA access to the proposal in the sponsor's submission system

### 4 business day before due date –

- Upload required documents into the sponsor's submission system
- Check the proposal package for errors

### Due Date –

- Review Guidelines for requirements and restrictions
- Review full proposal package and check for errors
- Email [ospa-proposals@iastate.edu](mailto:ospa-proposals@iastate.edu) (with Cc to the Grant Coordinator) letting them know you are ready to submit
- Sit back, relax and enjoy a job well done!

### NOTE:

**Add 5 business days to the timeline above for proposals with cost share commitments so approval can be obtained from all departmental chairs involved. And for proposals with multiple subcontracts.**

**Add 10 business days to the timeline for any proposals with a total budget of \$2M or more.**
