## Spring 2026 Registration in Workday — What to Know

Spring registration is underway! If you're running into issues in Workday, here are a few quick fixes and reminders to help things go smoothly.

**If you can't register**, start by checking for holds under "Action Items and Holds" in Workday. Common holds include missing address information, financial obligations, or academic restrictions. Clear these as soon as possible — they're the most common reason students can't add classes.

Seeing **"Only Reserved Seats Available"**? That means the remaining seats are reserved for specific majors or programs. You do not have access to the "Department Managed Seats." You'll need to select another section or contact the department if you believe you should have access. Reserved seats often open to all students later, so keep an eye on availability.

If a course still won't let you enroll, double-check prerequisites, your class standing, and whether the course is full. Also, make sure your major or program is correctly listed in Workday, as that can affect access to certain sections.

Finally, after registering, confirm your status shows "Enrolled," review your schedule for accuracy, and verify that your credits, billing, and financial aid are all correct.
