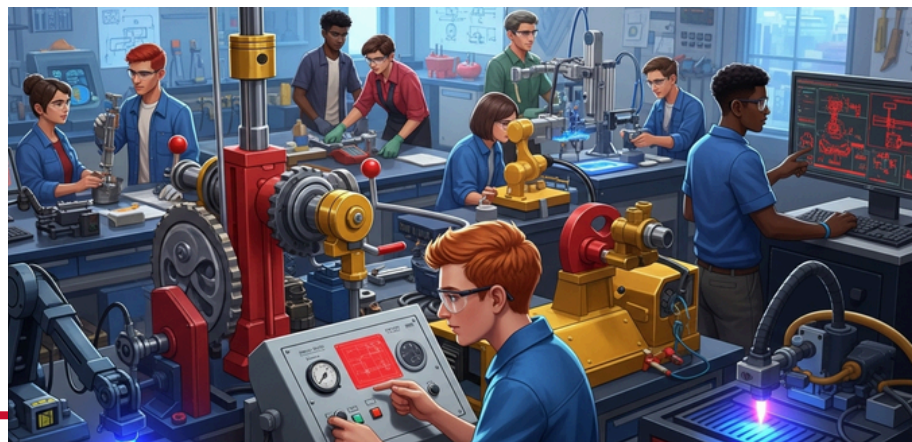
This scholarship recognizes students who show promise and are committed to building the future of the construction industry.
